## Membership Dues Options

### Regular Member Dues: \$235

Individuals shall be eligible for regular membership while they reside or maintain an office in King County and either (a) are licensed to practice law by the licensing authority of any state, the District of Columbia or Puerto Rico, and are in good standing in the jurisdiction where they are licensed, or (b) are full-time faculty members of a law school in the State of Washington.

### Associate Member Dues: \$135

Individuals shall be eligible for associate membership if they meet the eligibility requirements for regular membership except the requirement of residence per employment within the county. Associate members shall have all the rights and privileges of regular members, except the right to vote or hold office.

### Voting Rights: \$100

Associate members who elect to pay full dues may become a regular member with all the rights and privileges of regular members.

### Income Based Dues: \$95-\$320

For King County members only. Income information will be kept confidential.

**Order this format:** If you want both video and audio.

Audio-Visual (AV) Credits are credits earned via recorded, CLE credit approved courses.

Attorneys can claim up to 22.50 total AV Credits (including 6.00 Ethics Credits) per reporting period.

Written materials must be included with each AV program and reviewed by the applicant to earn credit.
