Ms. Carroll,

Thank you for taking a couple minutes to formally introduce yourself at the end of Friday's meeting. If I was abrupt in calling attention to the second statement out of your mouth (you apologized for my denial of admittance to last months KCBA FLS meeting in Courtroom 942 of the KCSC adding that you had no idea I and T. Bret Haggerty were refused entry) because it was pure and utter fabrication of the truth I apologize. Unlike some people when I have been lied to I like to "clear the air" as soon as possible, to your credit once caught in the lie you corrected your statement and verified that it was not accurate and you in fact did have knowledge that we were refused entry and that you communicated with at least KCSC Administrator Paul Sherrey prior that no entry would be allowed.

SEC: This is not accurate at all. I was very clear that I didn't know that you had been denied admittance. The court staff did let me know in advance that you had communicated that you would be attending, but also that you, and any member of the public, were to be welcomed. There was no catching anyone in a lie because during our relatively cordial conversation I do not believe that either of us were being dishonest.

Moving forward if you could simply state facts and truth rather than misstatements and outright fabrications I believe our relationship will likely be less confrontational and hopefully less litigious.

During our conversation while at first you refused you later changed your position on passing on my desire to obtain the lawfully requested records of these past Public Meetings, thank you.

SEC: I did agree to pass on the message that you would like the KCBA to reconsider their position and I have passed that message on.

During your opening statements you declared that the use of the Public's buildings and associated resources was diversion of public funds for a private cause, further responding to comments from the gallery that the decision is a final one and there would only be two more meetings. You also stated these were Public Meetings.

SEC: While the section has been told that we need to find a new meeting location, we are looking into all options at this point. There are two more meetings at the courthouse scheduled—the first Fridays of May and June. As I stated in our discussion, these meetings are open to the public and should be very interesting. The May meeting is on civility and professionalism. The June meeting is on representing clients who are CPS involved.

I am looking forward to your assistance in getting the public records released.
