COMES NOW the plaintiff's, Christopher Hupy moving the court for an order transferring this cause and all of its pending and future motions to an unbiased and disinterested Judicial Officer or En Banc Panel of Judges.

## II. STATEMENT OF FACTS

Defendant has motioned the court, in and through their counsel David Corey and/or Rebecca Ringer, for a Order Sealing the above mention action citing GR15(c). A hearing is scheduled on November 26<sup>th</sup>, 2014 in front of Snohomish County Superior Court Judge.

As of this date no discretionary rulings by any Superior Court Judge in this matter have been made.

Presently assigned SCSC Judge is a subordinate to one (or more) of the defendants (Michael Downes and/or Anita Farris) in action 14-2-06148-8, at present based on the doctrine of adoptive admissions (Admission by silence) the defendants have admitted to violating their Oaths of Office and violating the multiple provisions of the Washington State Constitution, these admissions are possibly grounds for removal from office and a forfeiture of any respective judicial retirement payment (tens of thousands of dollars if not hundreds of thousands of dollars). While this Judicial Officer is not specifically a named defendant at this point in time the Judicial Officers is in a superior position of knowledge concerning her complicity in this illegal activity for personal gain, based on her 20 year career and past service as Presiding Judge of SCSC, Assistant Presiding SCSC Judge, chair of the Court Operations Committee, not to mention her business partnership with the defendants as part of the illegal association of Superior Court Judges (see attached exhibit A).

Presently assigned Judge, by act or omission has denied plaintiff access to Judicial Intellectual Property required to comply with SCLR(s) to timely file this motion and/or other filed and/or unfiled motions, specifically Judicial Assignments were not published to the public until after business hours on November 21<sup>st</sup>, 2014 (see attached exhibit B). This overt action caused the time to hearing to be less than required time for proper notice to opposing party of this motion, this administrative Judicial action has denied my (and opposing party) right to due process of law. Discovered late last night is the fact that the Judicial Intellectual

1 Property was disclosed to the members of the Snohomish County BAR Association at some  
2 point prior to public dissemination (this date is believed to be on or before November 1<sup>st</sup>,  
3 2014) this denial of access to me and granted access to other members of her association  
4 represent a denial of due process to me and opposing party (see exhibit C).

5 Presently assigned Judge is a witness, at this point she is in control of intellectual  
6 property which the litigants in this case are denied of, specifically the fact she has a long term  
7 pattern of violating the rights of the plaintiff and the defendant by violating our rights under  
8 the Washington Constitution, via theft of public funds and resources.

9 Presently assigned Judge has also disqualified herself in 14-2-06148-8 via some secret  
10 back room discussion with the named defendants, the extent of these ex parte discussions are  
11 presently known to the Judge and are withheld from the litigants involved in the present cause  
(see attached exhibit D).

12 All "relevant facts" which a common man would rely upon to determine bias and  
13 prejudices have historically been actively concealed by the presently assigned Judge, but  
14 enough is known (presented with this motion and known to this SCSC Judicial Actor) that  
15 any involvement would be prejudicial and biased. Judicial Canon 2.11 is clear and concise on  
16 this issue Judge must disqualify himself or herself from the case.

17 Presently assigned Judge is in possession of evidence relevant to this case and the  
18 immediate proceedings, she is a witness and the litigants have a right to examine her  
19 concerning this. Washington Supreme Court Rule ER605 states "Competency of Judge as  
20 Witness- The judge presiding at the trial may not testify in that trial as a witness- No  
21 objection need be made in order to preserve the point." (Adopted effective April 2, 1979).  
Clear and literal language contained in this rule mandate this Judge disqualify herself.

**III. Evidence Relied Upon**

This Declaration of plaintiff Christopher Hupy in support of this motion, attached exhibits, all pleadings, filings, and any and all additional documents filed in this case. All additional Judicial Intellectual property disclosed or withheld presently in controlled by assigned SCSC Judge in which a reasonably prudent man would rely on to conclude or abolish a violation of the appearance of fairness of said Judicial Officer.

**IV. QUESTION PRESENTED-**

Does the Plaintiff have a right to a fair and impartial Judicial Officer free from the appearance of bias and prejudice? Does the Plaintiff (and the defendant) have the right to due process under the law?

**V. LEGAL AUTHORITY AND ARGUMENT**

In re Marriage of Meredith, 201 P. 3d 1056 Wash. COA Division II 2009, stated “Due process, the appearance of fairness, and Canon 3 (D)(1) of the Code of Judicial Conduct require that a judge disqualify him or herself from hearing a case if that judge is biased against a party or if his or her impartiality may be reasonably questioned.” The facts presented here leave only disqualification as a remedy; the court further ruled “The test for recusal is an objective one under either the appearance of fairness doctrine or the code of judicial conduct” Canon 2.11 specifies disqualification. In Diimmel v. Campbell, 68 Wash.2d 697, 699, 414 P.2d 1022 (1966) the Court ruled “It is incumbent upon members of the judiciary to avoid even a cause for suspicion of irregularity in the discharge of their duties.” State v. Madry, 8 Wn. App. 61, 70, 504 P.2d 1156 (1972) “The law goes farther than requiring an impartial judge; it also requires that the judge appear to be impartial.” In State v. Post, 118 Wn.2d 596, 618, 826 P.2d 172, 837 P.2d 599 619 (1992). The Court ruled “Without evidence of actual or potential bias, an appearance of fairness claim cannot succeed and is


1 *without merit*" The plaintiffs motion succeeds because of the overwhelming supporting  
2 evidence. **RCW 2.28.030 Judicial Officer Defined - When Disqualified-** *A Judicial Officer is*  
3 *a person authorized to act as a judge in a court of justice. Such officer shall not act in a court*  
4 *of which he or she is a member of any of the following cases: (1) In an action, suit or*  
5 *proceeding to which he or she is a party, or in which he or she is directly interested. The due*  
6 *process protections provided by the Washington State Constitution and United States*  
7 **Constitution. RCW 4.12.050 Prejudice of Judge, transfer to another department, visiting**  
8 **judge** *"(1) No judge of a superior court of the state of Washington shall sit to hear or try any*  
9 *action of proceeding when it shall be established as hereinafter provided that said judge is*  
10 *prejudiced against any party or attorney, or the interests of any party of attorney appearing*  
11 *in such cause..."*

1 **VI. CONCLUSION and RELIEF SOUGHT-**

2 Plaintiff have presented evidence which well exceeds the required showing  
3 demonstrating the appearance of bias, prejudice, and participation in similar activities  
4 (diversion of public resources and qualified dissemination of Intellectual Property) in which  
5 underlying relief is sought to establish violations and/or the appearance of violations of  
6 plaintiffs rights. Plaintiffs move the court for disqualification of the assigned SCSC  
7 (Snohomish County Superior Court) Judge and case be assigned to a non biased and impartial  
8 Judicial Officer and/or appointment of unbiased and disinterested En Banc panel.

9 I swear under penalty of perjury, as enforced in Snohomish County Superior Court, of  
10 the laws of the State of Washington the above motion/declaration to be true and accurate to  
11 the best of my knowledge and is submitted without malice or contempt for this or any other  
12 Court.




