My name is Charles Snyder, president judge of the Superior Court Judges' Association. Within the past six months, it has come to the attention of the Association that the name "Superior Court Judges' Association" is being used by a person who is not at all related to the statewide judges' association. We have worked with our legal representative at the Attorney General's Office to communicate and protect ourselves against damage, however, we understand how requests made to you might be misleading. This individual is intentional in his actions and communication. I urge you to use caution if you are contacted by anyone representing the "Superior Court Judges' Association". If the contact suggests that you visit a website, please be aware that the website may contain malware and may not be safe.
