**ORDER ON COMPLETION OF
CONDITIONS**

This matter comes before the Secretary of Health (Secretary) on request for completion of conditions brought by the Compliance Officer. The Presiding Officer, on designation by the Secretary of Health, issues the following:

1: PROCEDURAL STIPULATIONS

1.1 On December 10, 2001, the state of Washington issued Respondent a credential to practice as a mental health counselor. Respondent's credential is currently active.

1.2 The Compliance Officer requested completion of conditions of Respondent's credential to practice as a mental health counselor in the state of Washington without conditions.

1.3 This Order on Completion of Conditions, it is subject to the federal reporting requirements pursuant to Section 1128E of the Social Security Act and 45 CFR Part 61, RCW 18.130.110 and any other applicable interstate/national reporting requirements. It is a public document and will be available on the Department of Health web site.

2: FINDINGS OF FACT

2.1 On December 10, 2001, the state of Washington issued Respondent a credential to practice as a mental health counselor. Respondent's credential is currently active and subject to the Secretary's June 24, 2009 Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Final Order (June 24, 2009 Final Order). In the June 24, 2009 Final Order, Respondent was to comply with, among other terms, the following conditions:

A. The Respondent must pay a fine of \$100.00 within thirty (30) days of the issuance of this order.

2.2 The Compliance Officer requested completion of conditions of Respondent's credential to practice as a mental health counselor in the state of Washington without conditions.

2.3 The Program reviewed Respondent's file to determine compliance with the June 24, 2009 Final Order and concluded Respondent has substantially complied with the terms and conditions.

3: CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the Findings of Fact, the Health Law Judge makes the following Conclusions of Law:

3.1 The Secretary has jurisdiction over Respondent and over the subject matter of this proceeding.

3.2 The request for completion of conditions was brought properly before the Secretary.

3.3 Respondent's request for completion of conditions should be granted and the Program's oversight and monitoring of Respondent's compliance terminated.

4: ORDER


Based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Secretary orders:
