It is Ordered: Solomon Metalwala

1. Petitioner is **Restrained** from causing physical harm, bodily injury, assault, including sexual assault, and from molesting, harassing, threatening, or stalking petitioner the minors named in the table above these minors only:

(If the respondent's relationship to the petitioner is that of spouse or former spouse, parent of a common child, or former or current cohabitant as intimate partner, including current or former registered domestic partner, then effective immediately, and continuing as long as this protection order is in effect, the **Petitioner may not possess a firearm or ammunition.** 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(8). A violation of this federal firearms law carries a maximum possible penalty of 10 years in prison and a \$250,000 fine. An exception exists for law enforcement officers and military personnel when carrying department/government-issued firearms. 18 U.S.C. § 925(a)(1).)

2. Petitioner is **Restrained** from harassing, following, keeping under physical or electronic surveillance, cyberstalking as defined in RCW 9.61.260, and using telephonic, audiovisual, or other electronic means to monitor the actions, locations, or wire or electronic communication of petitioner the minors named in the table above only the minors listed below members of the victim's household listed below the victim's adult children listed below:

11 person must comply with the notice requirements of the Child Relocation Act. Persons entitled
12 to time with the child under a court order may object to the proposed relocation. See
13 RCW 26.09, RCW 26.10 or RCW 26.26 for more information.

14 **Warnings to the Petitioner:** A violation of provisions 1 through 6 of this order with actual notice of its terms
15 is a criminal offense under chapter 26.50 RCW and will subject you to arrest. If the violation of the protection order
16 involves travel across a state line or the boundary of a tribal jurisdiction, or involves conduct within the special
17 maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, which includes tribal lands, you may be subject to criminal
18 prosecution in federal court under 18 U.S.C. §§ 2261, 2261A, or 2262.

19 A violation of provisions 1 through 6, 14, or 15 of this order is a gross misdemeanor unless one of the following
20 conditions apply: Any assault that is a violation of this order and that does not amount to assault in the first degree or
21 second degree under RCW 9A.36.011 or 9A.36.021 is a class C felony. Any conduct in violation of this order that is
22 reckless and creates a substantial risk of death or serious physical injury to another person is a class C felony. Also, a
23 violation of this order is a class C felony if you have at least two previous convictions for violating a protection order
24 issued under Titles 7, 10, 26 or 74 RCW.

25 If you are convicted of an offense of domestic violence, you will be forbidden for life from possessing a firearm or
26 ammunition. 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(9); RCW 9A.1.040.

27 **You Can Be Arrested Even if the Person or Persons Who Obtained the Order Invite or**
28 **Allow You to Violate the Order's Prohibitions.** You have the sole responsibility to avoid or refrain from
violating the order's provisions. Only the court can change the order upon written application.

Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2265, a court in any of the 50 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, any United States
territory, and any tribal land within the United States shall accord full faith and credit to the order.

It is further ordered that the clerk of the court shall forward a copy of this order on or before the next
judicial day to _____ County Sheriff's Office
Police Department **Where Petitioner Lives** which shall enter it in a computer-based criminal
intelligence system available in this state used by law enforcement to list outstanding warrants.

Service

The clerk of the court shall also forward a copy of this order on or before the next judicial day to
King County County Sheriff's Office Police
Department **Where Petitioner Lives** which shall personally serve the Petitioner with a copy of
this order and shall promptly complete and return to this court proof of service.

Petitioner shall serve this order by mail publication.

Petitioner shall make private arrangements for service of this order.

Petitioner appeared and was informed of the order by the court; further service is not required.



If the duration of this order exceeds one year, the court finds that an order of one year or less will be insufficient to prevent further acts of domestic violence.


