III. Order

It is Ordered:

3.1 Restraining Order

Violation of a Restraining Order in paragraph 3.1 with actual notice of its terms is a criminal offense under Chapter 26.50 RCW and will subject the violator to arrest. RCW 26.09.060.

The petitioner is restrained and enjoined from disturbing the peace of the other party or of any child. The petitioner is restrained and enjoined from going onto the grounds of or entering the home, work place or school of the other party, or the day care or school of the following named children: Maile Grace Metalwala and Sky Elijah Metalwala.

The petitioner is restrained and enjoined from knowingly coming within or knowingly remaining within 500 feet of the home, work place or school of the other party, or the day care or school of these children: Maile Grace Metalwala and Sky Elijah Metalwala. *Except during school - d.v. visit*
 Solomon Metalwala is restrained and enjoined from molesting, assaulting, harassing or stalking Julia Biryukova.

Clerk's Action/Law Enforcement Action

This order shall be filed forthwith in the clerk's office and entered of record. The clerk of the court shall forward a copy of this order on or before the next judicial day to the King County Sheriff's Office which shall forthwith enter this order into any computer-based criminal intelligence system available in this state used by law enforcement agencies to list outstanding warrants.

The protected party or the protected party's attorney must complete a law enforcement information sheet and provide it with this order before this order will be entered into the law enforcement computer system.

2 This restraining order will expire in 12 months and shall be removed from any computer-based
3 criminal intelligence system available in this state used by law enforcement agencies to list
4 outstanding warrants, unless a new order is issued, or unless the court sets forth another
5 expiration date here: (month/day/year) March 3, 2012.

6 **Full Faith and Credit**

7 Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2265, a court in any of the 50 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico,
8 any United States territory, and any tribal land within the United States shall accord full faith and
9 credit to the order.

10 **3.2 Temporary Relief**

11 3.2.1 The petitioner shall pay the other party ¹²⁰⁰ ~~\$1,500~~ per month maintenance.
12 Starting Date: March 1, 2011
13 Day(s) of the month payment is due: January 1, 2010
14 1st and the 15th
15 Mr. Metalwala will pay \$1000⁰⁰ on the 1st and \$910⁰⁰ on the 15th of each month for both child support and spousal maintenance.

16 3.2.2 Payments shall be made to the Washington State Child Support Registry (if child support is ordered).

17 3.3.3 Child support shall be paid in accordance with the order of child support, ^{previously} signed by the court.

18 3.3.4 The parties shall comply with the ~~Temporary Parenting Plan~~ signed by the court. visitation scheduled in the DVPO record on this date.

19 3.3.5 Use of property shall be as follows: Respondent shall have use of the parties' furniture and home furnishings which are currently being stored in the Petitioner's mother's garage or house.

20 3.3.6 The petitioner shall pay temporary attorney fees, other professional fees and costs in the amount of ~~\$5,000~~ ^{\$2,000} to: Veronica Freitas.

21 3.3.7 This matter is referred to Family Court Services for a Parenting Evaluation.

22 3.3.8 The Petitioner shall complete a Domestic Violence evaluation from Wellspring Family Services or Doug Bartholomew or other agreed upon provider.




