- 1) THE CHILDREN SHALL REMAIN WITH THE FATHER.
- 2) THE MOTHER SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING VISITATION WITH THE CHILDREN: MAILE - UNLIMITED VISITATION MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY AT MAILE'S DAYCARE (ELITE KIDS IN KIRKLAND) OR 10:30 A.M. TO 6:00 P.M., SUPERVISED BY THE MATERNAL GRANDMOTHER OR OTHER AGREED UPON PERSON. SKY: FROM 12:00 NOON TO 4:00 P.M. ON EACH OF SATURDAY (SUPERVISED BY STAN BIRYUKOVO), SUNDAY (SUPERVISED BY STAN BIRYUKOVO), AND MONDAY (SUPERVISED BY SUE JEWETT). EACH OF THESE VISITS SHALL OCCUR AT STAN BIRYUKOVO'S MOTHER'S HOUSE THE RECEIVING PARENT SHALL PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION.
- 3) WHOEVER PROVIDES VISITATION SUPERVISION SHALL SIGN THE AGREEMENT AND OATH OF VISITATION SUPERVISOR PRIOR TO PROVIDING SUPERVISION. (except daycare)
- 4) ALL COMMUNICATION SHALL BE BETWEEN COUNSEL OR BY EMAIL WITH BOTH ATTORNEYS COPIED ON EACH EMAIL COMMUNICATION. (respectful email only as to parenting issues).

IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT TO THE COURT THAT THE MOTHER PARTICIPATE IN COUNSELING. THE FATHER SHALL MAKE THE FOLLOWING FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTIONS TOWARD THE MOTHER'S COUNSELING: maintain her health insurance and provide / advance any uncovered expenses for counseling.
