10 **3.1 Restraining Order**

11 *Violation of a Restraining Order in paragraph 3.1 with actual notice of its terms is a criminal*  
 12 *offense under Chapter 26.50 RCW and will subject the violator to arrest. RCW 26.09.060.*

13 *PARTIES ARE*  
 The petitioner is restrained and enjoined from disturbing the peace of the other party or of any child.  
 14 *PARTIES ARE*  
 The petitioner is restrained and enjoined from going onto the grounds of or entering the home,  
 15 *PARTIES ARE*  
 work place or school of the other party, or the day care or school of the following named children:  
 Maile Grace Metalwala and Sky Elijah Metalwala.

16 The petitioner is restrained and enjoined from knowingly coming within or knowingly remaining  
 17 within 100 feet of the home, work place or school of the other party, or the day care or school of  
 these children: Maile Grace Metalwala and Sky Elijah Metalwala.

18 Solomon Metalwala is restrained and enjoined from molesting, assaulting, harassing or stalking  
 Julia Biryakova.

19 *\* EXCEPT FOR PARENTING ORP OFFS & PICKUP.*

20 This order shall be filed forthwith in the clerk's office and entered of record. The clerk of  
 21 the court shall forward a copy of this order on or before the next judicial day to the King  
 22 County Sheriff's Office which shall forthwith enter this order into any computer-based  
 criminal intelligence system available in this state used by law enforcement agencies to list  
 outstanding warrants.

4 outstanding warrants, unless a new order is issued, or unless the court sets forth another

6 **Full Faith and Credit**

7 Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2265, a court in any of the 50 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico,  
8 any United States territory, and any tribal land within the United States shall accord full faith and  
9 credit to the order.

10 **3.2 Temporary Relief**

19 in any way disposing of any property except in the usual course of business or for the necessities of  
20 life and requiring each party to notify the other of any extraordinary expenditures made after the  
21 order is issued.

22 3.3.6 ~~The petitioner is~~ <sup>PARTIES ARE</sup> restrained and enjoined from removing any of the children from the state of  
23 Washington.

24 3.3.7 ~~The petitioner is~~ <sup>PARTIES ARE</sup> restrained and enjoined from assigning, transferring, borrowing, lapsing,  
25 surrendering or changing entitlement of any insurance policies of either or both parties whether  
26 medical, health, life or auto insurance.

27 3.3.8 Each party shall be immediately responsible for their own future debts whether incurred by credit  
28 card or loan, security interest or mortgage.

3.3.9 Use of property shall be as follows: ~~Respondent~~ <sup>Petitioner</sup> shall have use of the parties' 2002 Cadillac  
Escalade. Petitioner shall return all of Respondent's personal property including her clothing  
immediately. Respondent shall return all of the children's clothing and personal property to the  
Respondent immediately.
